# Perceiving, Interpreting and Enhancing Energy in Organisations and Eco-systems

#### **Credits and Certification**

This course provides 4 credits for Wisdom University students. In combination with a follow-up 3-day training (17-19 November 2011), this course provides students with a full Year 1 Diploma in ECOtherapy.

#### Overview

This is a world first in many ways!

- the *first* event in the *first* full academic year of the Wisdom University in Europe!
- the *first* time that the energetic work of Hans Andeweg has been taught comprehensively in English!
- the *first* time that the standard first year of ECOtherapy training has been offered in a compact course!

This 5-day intensive will introduce the fundamentals of energy work in companies and eco-systems:

- how to perceive energy using the different senses available to us
- how to interpret energy using the latest science in this field
- how to enhance energy using intuitive practices

The course combines theory and practice in a location that has been recently energetically balanced and where many different energies are available to explore. Rooted in 20 years of experience in the field, this intensive weaves together the wisdom of our ancient past with the frontier science of the future – to help us make a grounded and inspired contribution in the challenges of the present.

## **Course Description**

The program is currently planned to include:

#### Day 1

- Muscle testing: life energy creates life force creates muscle strength
- Perceiving and interpreting the energetic radiance of the floor/ ground, the astral and mental energies on the ceiling, and the incoming cosmic energy

#### Day 2

- Perceiving energy with dowsing rods
- Perceiving and interpreting the energetic radiation of a plant and a tree
- Overlapping radiances of trees and the direction of energy in the trunk and as an example for communication in nature and human society
- The importance of grounding for a harmonious, powerful and relaxed energy for humans, plants, a room and a building
- Healing a piece of land with our hands

#### Day 3

- Seeing the ground radiance clairvoyantly
- Making a pendulum and dowsing in the Huna tradition
- The Huna's understanding of the human, and the meaning of higher-, middle- and lower selves for dowsing
- Dowsing floor/ground radiation and cosmic energy
- Dowsing etheric and astral energies in a building and in nature
- Origin, use and meaning of the Bovis scale as a measure of wholeness
- Dowsing the Bovis values of food, plants, trees and a room
- Healing a large piece of land or an indoor area by "putting it in its sun"

#### Day 4


- Rupert Sheldrake's theory of morphic fields
- Perceiving the radiance, cosmic energy and grounding at a distance with a map
- Case story of ECOtherapy at the Kennemer dunes or Duinlust organisation
- Energetic excursion to the nature reserve Kennemer Dunes
- Perceiving the energy of the dunes, the beach and the sea
- The power of shells; using shells to ground and charge yourself
- Perceiving the energy and influence of the local warden / guardian on the Kennemer dunes.
- Visiting a power site and perceiving nature elementals


#### Day 5

- Foundations for energetic guardianship
- The power of intention and fixed beliefs
- Perceiving the power of our intention on plants
- Getting chance on your side with the use of affirmations
- Healing a place or a tree at a point in the future and perceiving the effects in the present









### Faculty



Hans Andeweg MSc is co-founder of the Centre for ECOtherapy. The Centre energetically balances over 100 projects a year in Europe and is in charge of the 4-year vocational training to become an ECOtherapist. <a href="https://www.ecotherapy.org">www.ecotherapy.org</a>

Hans Andeweg studied biology. His studies consisted also of management and marketing, philosophy, psychology and pedagogic education. He has a background in cabaret and pop-music too. He was head of the department of agriculture of the Louis Bolk Institute in Driebergen. In 1990 he started working in Germany, at the Institute for Resonance-therapy (IRT) to help develop a method to heal diseased eco- and organization-systems. This resonance-therapy was very successful, but Hans missed the involvement of the people on the spot. He therefore wrote the book 'In resonance with nature', from which ECOtherapy developed. The Centre for ECOtherapy was founded 2001.

**Peter Merry** is a co-founder of Wisdom University in Europe. He is also Chair of the Center for Human Emergence (NL) – <a href="https://www.humanemergence.nl">www.humanemergence.nl</a>, and a founding partner of Engage! (<a href="https://www.engagency.nl">www.engagency.nl</a>).



He has worked in and across different sectors. His experience includes facilitating integral change processes in multinational corporations, and government ministries, and in global multistakeholder initiatives.

He is a recognised expert in the field of evolutionary systems dynamics. He has had his first book published in English and Dutch (Evolutionary Leadership). He is an experienced designer of learning processes and host of collective inquiry and collaboration. He also has a background in theatre and folk music.

His current focus is on researching the application of noetic science, geomancy and quantum physics to whole systems transitions. As part of this, he is a PhD student with <u>Wisdom University</u> and in the advanced stages of <u>ECOtherapy</u> training.

## **ECOtherapy**

ECOtherapy is a remote healing method, making use of an aerial photograph or a map, life energy, sound, colour, symbols and other energetic remedies. It improves the vitality and self-organisation of ecosystems and organization-systems, in co-operation with the manager responsible, who is known as the guardian of the project. ECOtherapy can be applied worldwide, both on a small and large scale. The goals of the guardian are usually met within a year.

'Eco' stems from the Greek word oikos, meaning house or home. We find the word in economy and ecosystem. In ECOtherapy 'ECO' means home in the broadest sense of the word, i.e. living-environment, house or work-environment. This includes every eco- or organization-system. There are a lot of places where plants and animals live, and where people live and work. Earth is, in the end the home of us all.

ECOtherapy can be applied to the natural, ecological environment and to the environment created by people, which is affected by economic forces. Think of nature reserves and estates, production companies, companies in the service sector, but also organizations for events, conferences and concerts. For lasting health and vitality, ECOnomy and ECOlogy need to be in balance.

The effect of ECOtherapy can be seen and measured in forests and nature reserves that are healthier and have more vitality, often with increasing biodiversity. For organizations it brings, among other things, a higher yield, more leisure time, staff that are happier and a better financial result. Lasting processes of change (reorganizations) within complex organizations can be realized in a relatively short period of time.
